# What is a CMS?

- A **content management system (CMS)** is a system providing a collection of procedures used to manage work flow in a collaborative environment. These procedures can be manual or computer-based. The procedures are designed to do the following:
  - Allow for a large number of people to contribute to and share stored data
  - Control access to data, based on user roles (defining which information users or user groups can view, edit, publish, etc.)
  - Aid in easy storage and retrieval of data
  - Reduce repetitive duplicate input
  - Improve the ease of report writing
  - Improve communication between users

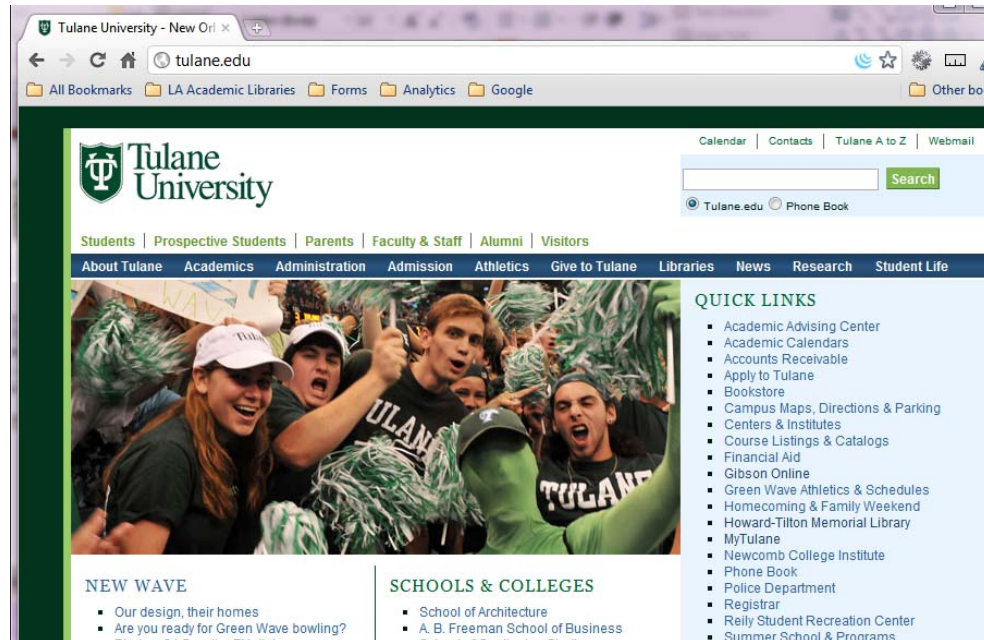


# Advantages of CMS

# Why Drupal for Tulane?

- Drupal was based on PHP and MYSQL – with which both of our developers had familiarity
- Adopted by many libraries
- Much simpler to use and implement than CS



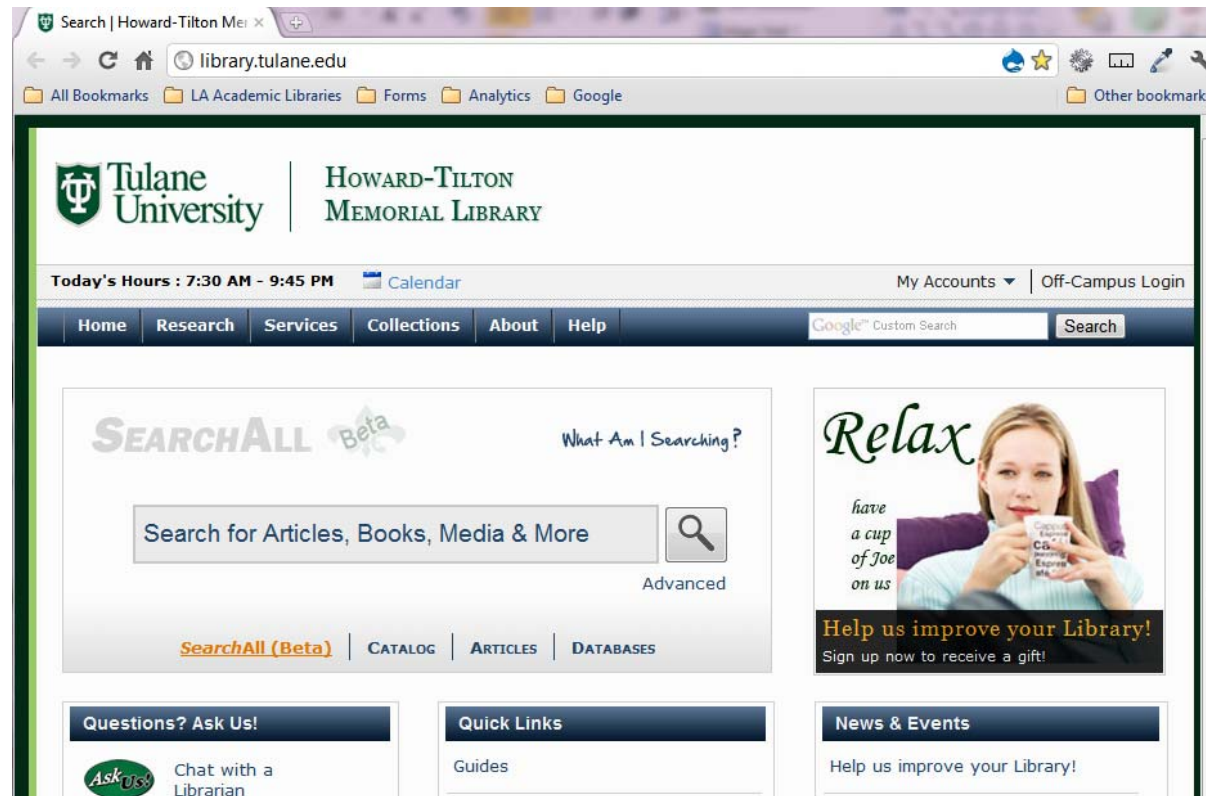
# Drupal in Libraries

# Drupal and Redesign

- Switch to Drupal was by far the easiest part of the redesign process
- Biggest task was cleanup of the existing HTML
- We copied text from the browser, then pasted into Dreamweaver's WYSIWYG editor
- We then took the source code from Dreamweaver and pasted that into Drupal

For example, if you install many contributed modules and contributed themes, the actual disk space for your installation could easily be (and likely will be) larger than 60 MB (exclusive of database content, media, backups and other files which should be considered too when planning for your site).

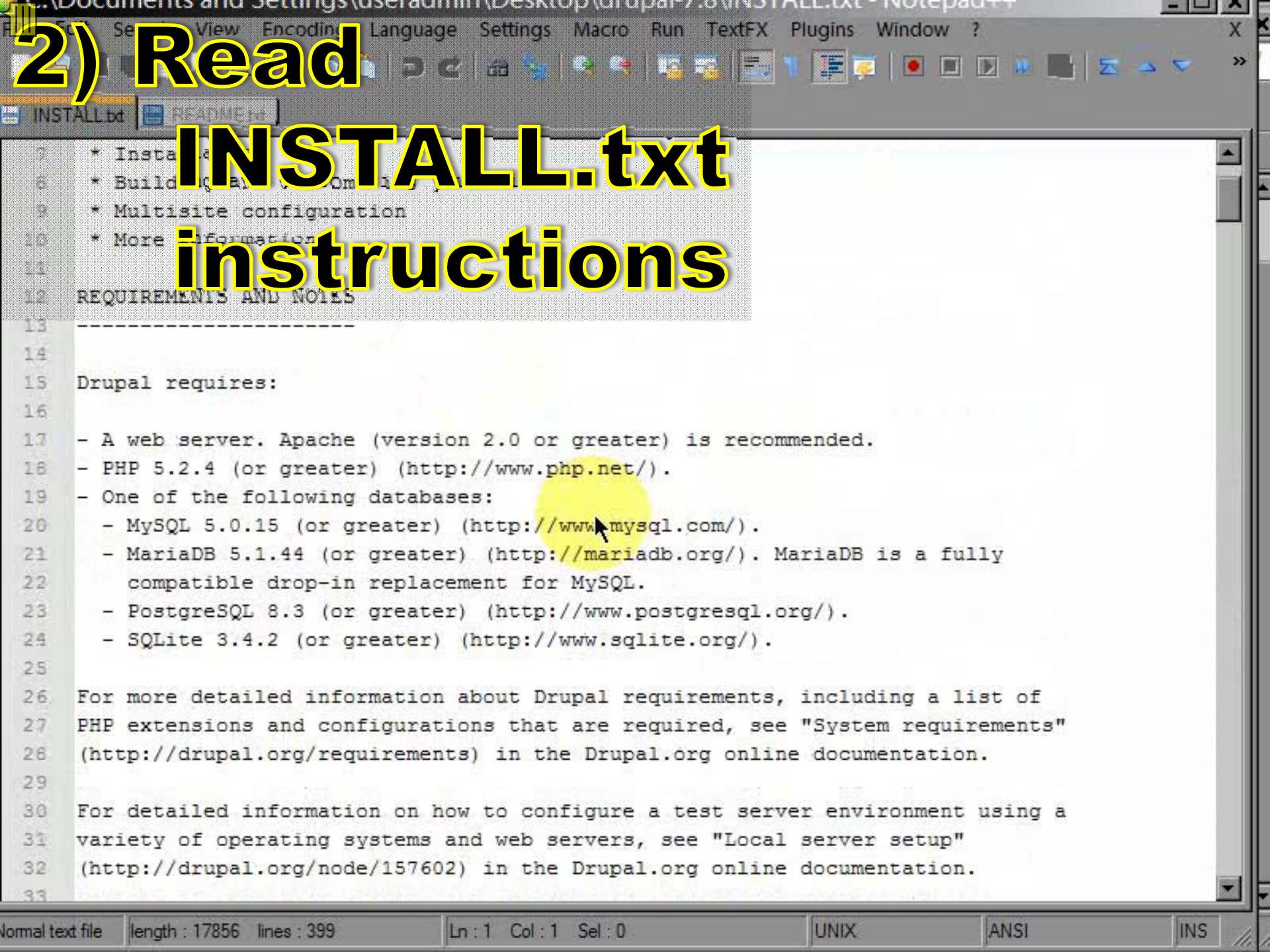

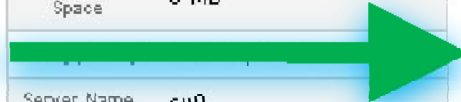

## Dedicated Tax Line for NJ Public and Joint Libraries

### UPDATE:

We are pleased to announce Governor Christie signed the Municipal Library Tax Levy Law (S2068/A2679). The passage of this legislation was extremely important to NJLA because it treats communities which support municipal and joint libraries the same as those which support county libraries.

The primary sponsors of this legislation were Senator Nia Gill and Assemblymen Upendra Chivukula, Ruben Ramos and Assemblywoman Valerie Vainieri Huttle. Additional sponsors were: Senator Sandra Cunningham on the Senate side and on the Assembly side Assemblyman John McKeon, Jason O'Donnell, Thomas Giblin and Assemblywomen Amy Handlin and Mila Jasey. Former Assemblyman Frederick Scalera was also a sponsor.

We are very thankful for the efforts of all these legislators in getting this bill passed.

1. This bill requires municipalities in which a free public library is located, or that belong to a joint municipal library, to provide for a dedicated library purposes tax on the property tax bill.
2. The bill removes the appropriations for municipal libraries and joint municipal libraries from a municipality's general fund.
3. Under this legislation local municipal caps will be recalculated so that they do not include the 1/3 mil dedicated library funding.
4. Any funding above 1/3 mil would have to be included in the municipality's cap.
5. The legislation provides fiscal parity for communities which support municipal and joint libraries with those that support a county library system. Each was established by referendum.
6. Under previous law, only property taxpayers in a municipality which belonged to a county library received property tax bills which include a line item showing the amount the taxpayer is paying to support the county library. This will now also be done for communities which support municipal and joint libraries. The legislation provides fiscal transparency for library funding.

Some time ago, libraries began using less print materials and more online database, allowing faster access from anywhere. But what if you *couldn't get your journals online either*? It could happen.

Academic library databases cost a lot of money, and [LOUIS: The Louisiana Library Network](#) makes it possible for **over 47** Louisiana academic libraries to afford them. However, funding for LOUIS has been cut, threatening academic research and education in Louisiana.
