

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



What is a CMS?

- A content management system (CMS) is a system providing a collection of procedures used to manage work flow in a collaborative environment. These procedures can be manual or computer-based. The procedures are designed to do the following:
- Allow for a large number of people to contribute to and share stored data
- Control access to data, based on user roles (defining which information users or user groups can view, edit, publish, etc.)
- Aid in easy storage and retrieval of data
- Reduce repetitive duplicate input
- Improve the ease of report writing
- Improve communication between users



- Much simpler to use and implement than CS





Drupal and Redesign

- Switch to Drupal was by far the easiest part of the redesign process
- Biggest task was cleanup of the existing HTML
- We copied text from the browser, then pasted into Dreamweaver's WYSIWYG editor
- We then took the source code from Dreamweaver and pasted that into Drupal

Note: if you meet these requirements but still have problems with your site, be sure to read through the Webhosting Troubleshooting FAQ.

To install and run Drupal, you need the following components (described in detail in sections below):

- Disk space
- Web server (e.g., Apache)
- Database server (e.g., MySQL)
- PHP

See the phpinfo() page on Drupal.org to learn how to use phpinfo to get the details of your system. For example, phpinfo will tell you if you have a database already installed and what versions of PHP, MySQL, etc. your system is running. Phpinfo will also tell you what PHP variables are set as well as many other helpful things.

Disk space

A minimum base installation requires at least 15MB of disk space but you should assume that your actual disk space needs will be much larger.

For example, if you install many contributed modules and contributed themes, the actual disk space for your installation could easily be (and likely will be) larger than 60 MB (exclusive of database content, media, backups and other files which should be considered too when planning for your site).

We are pleased to announce Governor Christie signed the Municipal Library Tax Levy Law (S2068/A2679). The passage of this legislation was extremely important to NJLA because it treats communities which support municipal and joint libraries the same as those which support county libraries.

The primary sponsors of this legislation were Senator Nia Gill and Assemblymen Upendra Chivukula, Ruben Ramos and Assemblywoman Valerie Vainieri Huttle. Additional sponsors were: Senator Sandra Cunningham on the Senate side and on the Assembly side Assemblyman John McKeon, Jason O'Donnell, Thomas Giblin and Assemblywomen Amy Handlin and Mila Jasey. Former Assemblyman Frederick Scalera was also a sponsor.

We are very thankful for the efforts of all these legislators in getting this bill passed.

- This bill requires municipalities in which a free public library is located, or that belong to a joint municipal library, to provide for a dedicated library purposes tax on the property tax bill.
- The bill removes the appropriations for municipal libraries and joint municipal libraries from a municipality's general fund.
- Under this legislation local municipal caps will be recalculated so that they do not include the 1/3 mil dedicated library funding.
- 4. Any funding above 1/3 mil would have to be included in the municipality's cap.
- The legislation provides fiscal parity for communities which support municipal and joint libraries with those that support a county library system. Each was established by referendum.
- 6. Under previous law, only property taxpayers in a municipality which belonged to a county library received property tax bills which include a line item showing the amount the taxpayer is paying to support the county library. This will now also be done for communities which support municipal and joint libraries. The legislation provides fiscal transparency for library funding.
